

LOGISTICS AND COMMUNICATIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Colorado Indigenous Games Society (CIGS) understands that advanced technology and logistical planning can benefit teams greatly at the Games. Games technology also benefits each delegation operations in case the activation of an emergency action plan in the event of a dangerous situation for all delegation members. For these reasons, CIGS will source and acquire the best equipment and logistical services available for use during the 2006 NAIG.

GAMES CALL CENTER

CIGS will staff and operate a Games Call Center, which will operate on a daily basis throughout the Games. This Call Center will be located at the Headquarters Hotel. When a call is received, a message will be send to the Athlete's Village where the participant is staying for the Games, and a message will be placed on a message board in the front office of the Athlete's Village. The receiver can then check the front office of the Athlete's Village when it is convenient to them. Additionally, the Call Center will place a message in the box of the Chef de Mission who will inform the athlete to return the call as soon as possible. This method of handling calls will eliminate calls at odd hours of the night and will provide for optimal performance environments.

NOTE: In the event of an emergency, the Call Center will attempt to reach the Village Director or his designee, who will then locate the call recipient for this call. Emergencies consist of a life threatening or life altering illness or incident. This does not include a call informing that the household appliance has broken down.

Nextel Two-Way Radios

CIGS Staff has secured a sponsor for Nextel Two-Way Radios. The radios also include a cell phone, but will not have allocated minutes and will not be available to anyone using one of the two-way radios.

Each sports commissioner, venue manager and staff member will be given a Nextel Two-way Radio. The sponsor will program each name and number into the phone previous to distributing the phones. A half an hour training for the Nextel Two-Way Radios will be scheduled for June 30 or July 1.

Nextel Two-Way Radios will be available to Chef de Missions and their delegations in their own, personal contract. Information about how to obtain Nextel Two-Way Radios for your delegations will be posted on the NAIG 2006 web site

SHIPPING AND LOGISTICAL SERVICES

All supplies, product and equipment bound for the 2006 NAIG must arrive at the CIGS Games Warehouse no later than **Friday June 16, 2006**. All packaging should be clearly marked with Team name and destination in Denver. (i.e. Athlete's Village/Headquarters Hotel/Basketball Venue/ Swimming Venue etc.) Each box should have an individual packing list attached detailing the contents and total value. Please number your boxes (1 of 10, 2 of 10 etc.) and keep a record of what was in each box in case a box ends up missing.
