

ARCHERY

ATHLETICS

The Athletic competition consists of Cross Country and Track & Field Competition. Cross Country will be held on Monday July 3, 2006. Track & Field will be held Wednesday, July 5 through Friday, July 7, 2006.

- Events are either in heats or finals depending upon the number of entries in each event.
- The 2006 NAIG Athletics will not offer Special Olympics.

BADMINTON

Badminton competition will be from Wednesday July 5 through Friday July 8 with medal round games scheduled for Friday.

- Each game is played to 15 points except for women's singles, which will be played to 11 points. If the score becomes 14 all (10 all in women's singles) the side which first scored 14 points (10 points in the case of women's single) shall have the choice of setting or not setting the game.
- Playoff games will take place for the bronze medal position.
- CIGS will supply all shuttlecocks for play

Men 20+ - Games will be played at South High School
Women 20+ - Games will be played at Thomas Jefferson High School

Game Times – Games will begin at 7:30 am and the last game of the day will begin at 7:00 pm.

Competition Notes:

- Round robin play with each team playing a minimum of three games during the week. The top 8 teams where applicable will advance to the playoff round with single elimination.
- All games will consist of 2 twenty minute half's with running time. The clock will stop the last 2 minutes of each half. The clock will not stop the last two minutes of a game if a team is up by 10 or more points.
- Each game will be officiated by 2 referees not 3 referees.
- During the week practice courts at the venues will not be available to teams because of the tight competition schedule

Game Times – Games will begin at 8:00 am and the last game of the day will begin at 4:00 pm.

Competition Notes:

- Round robin play with each team playing a minimum of three games during the week. The top 4 teams where applicable will advance to the playoff round with single elimination. If a classification only contains four teams, then all four teams will advance to the semi-final round.
- A game shall consist of seven (7) innings. No new innings shall start after 1 hour and 40 minutes. If the game is tied after the time has expired, the tiebreaker rule shall be in effect at the start of the next inning.
- Run ahead rule: 15 runs ahead after 3 innings or 8 runs ahead after 5 innings. Complete inning must be played unless the home team scores the run ahead limit while at bat.
- In the case of a tie for the last playoff position, the rules and regulations of the International Softball Federation shall be followed.
- CIGS will supply all game balls
- CIGS will provide bottled water and sports drink or juice during and after the game
- CIGS will provide medical support/trainers at each game
- Competition will be conducted under ASA rules

SOCCKER

Soccer competition will be from Monday July 3 through Friday July 8 with medal round games scheduled for Friday.

Girls 17-19 – Games will be played at New Vista Middle School

Medal round games may be played at Region High School which has two turf fields.

Competition Notes:

- Teams from the following classifications will play three games in round robin play:
Bantam Girls, Midget Boys, Midget Girls and Juvenile Boys.
- Teams from the following classifications will play four games in round robin play:
Bantam Boys and Juvenile Girls.
- Teams will receive 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. In a tie situation (playoff games only) at the end of regulation time, FIFA tiebreaker rules will apply.
- **For teams playing three opening round games only:** At the conclusion of round-robin play, the top 4 seeds from each classification will advance to the semi-final round. If a classification only contains four teams, then all four teams will advance to the semi-final round.
- **For teams playing four opening round games:** The top two seeds from round robin play will meet in the championship game. Seeds #3 and #4 will meet in the bronze medal game.
- Before the semi-final round, advancing teams will be seeded according to the number of points accumulated in round robin play. The team with the most points will be the #1 seed, the team with the second most points will be the #2 seed and so on. In the semi-final round, the #1 seed will meet the #4 seed and the #2 seed will face the #3 seed.
- CIGS will supply all game balls
- CIGS will provide bottled water and sports drink or juice during and after the game
- CIGS will provide medical support/trainers at each game
- Competition will be conducted under FIFA rules

SWIMMING

Competition Notes:

- Round robin play with each team playing a minimum of three games during the week. The top 6 or 8 teams where applicable will advance to the playoff round with single elimination.
- A team wins a match by winning 3 out of 5 games. Scoring format will be rally scoring, no side out, and games to 25 with a minimum lead of two points. In the case of a 2-2 tie, the deciding 5th game is played to 15 points with a minimum lead of two points, no cap via rally scoring.
- CIGS will supply all game balls
- CIGS will provide bottled water and sports drink or juice during and after the game
- CIGS will provide medical support/trainers at each game
- Competition will be conducted under FIVB rules

WRESTLING
