#### APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY GUARDIANSHIP

To: All Team Saskatchewan Participants

Re: LETTER TO APPOINT TEMPORARY GUARDIANSHIP – NAIG

Dear Friend,

Passports are not enforced through legislation until January 2007 and are recommended but not necessary for travel to the United States. NAIG Team Saskatchewan is working closely with RCMP and Canadian Customs on our contingency travel plan to the U.S. and Denver, Colorado.

Foreign Affairs Canada has legislation that impacts travel arrangements for Canadian citizens traveling to the United States. For all Canadian Citizens 18 years or older they must provide upon request a Birth Certificate and/or Treaty Card as well as; Registered picture identification (i.e. Drivers License, Passport). If a person 18 years or older does not have a Drivers license then a registered picture identification is needed (ie, \$10.00 at any SGI certified license distributor or Passport photo).

For all Canadian citizens under the age of 18 years the requirements are very strict. A letter is needed to appoint temporary guardianship to the adult coach and/or chaperone supervising the minor. This document will have both biological parents and/or legal guardian consent and signature prior to being granted entry into the United States. In some cases the legal document appointing the legal guardian for a minor is needed do to cases settled through the justice system. This document must be witnessed by a notary public and signed as a registered document.

If you require extra information please work with your coaches at upcoming training and/or events to complete this task by June 15, 2006 as we prepare for our upcoming departure for the U.S Border and Denver, Colorado
