DEPARTURE: Friday, August 1, 2008 **ALL BUSES** depart from **SASKATOON**

LOCATION: Credit Union Centre (parking lot)
Saskatoon, Sask.

TIME: Registration and Bus Assignments
BUSES begin loading at 9:30 a.m.

MANDATORY FOR ALL ATHELETES TO BE TRANSPORTED BY TEAM SASK BUS

9:30 a.m. ALL buses and Athletes prepare for departure
registration, baggage check and loading

10:30 a.m. FINAL call for boarding

10:45 a.m. **DEPARTURE**

11:00 a.m. Depart Saskatoon for Edmonton

4:30 p.m. Supper stop (1.5 hours)

6:00 p.m. Depart Edmonton for Hinton, Alberta

9:00 p.m. Hinton, Alberta, short break, fuel buses, driver switch (1 hour)

10:00 p.m. depart Hinton for Kamloops (NOTE B.C. TIME CHANGE)

5:00 a.m. Kamloops, BC, breakfast stop (2 hour break)

7:00 a.m. Depart for Kamloops for Tsawwassen Ferry

11:00 a.m. Tsawwassen Ferry arrival (1.45 break)

12:45 p.m. Ferry departure for Duncan, BC. (Approx 2 hour ferry ride)

4:00 p.m. Approximate arrival in Duncan, BC.

NOTES:

- At each scheduled bus stop, passengers are encouraged to use washrooms facilities when possible (other than the bus restroom).
- All garbage refuse in bus **MUST BE** deposited into garbage bags at all times during your bus ride, help keep your seating area clean.
- Team Sask buses have a **VERY CRITICAL** time schedule to follow
- It is VERY IMPORTANT that each passenger understand in order to make our scheduled ferry time, each stop made, **time is a factor!**

LUGGAGE

ALLOWABLE per person:

All participants are limited to the amount of luggage allowed on the bus. The following is your luggage allowance:

All passengers will be issued a Team Sask luggage identification tag at registration to place on your belongings.

1 equipment bag (e.g. single ball bag, golf bag, etc. which will be placed in the equipment truck)

1 suitcase with the allowable dimensions/weight:

150 cm (60 in) 20 kgs (40lbs)

ONE SMALL back pack with your personal items for bus, for example:

1 back pack	snacks
1 small travel pillow	drinks

ENSURE: that you pack snacks and drinks for the ride, as there are a limited number of stops.

BEDDING IS NOT REQUIRED AND WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE NAIG HOST SOCIETY.

IT IS MANDATORY TO ENSURE SAFETY OF ALL PASSENGERS. THEREFORE, ALL BAGGAGE WILL BE SEARCHED PRIOR TO BUS LOADING. NO PASSENGER WILL BE EXEMPT FROM BAGGAGE SEARCH.
